1. Duolingo: An Overview

The Duolingo English Test is an online test that assesses English proficiency through reading, writing, speaking, and listening skills. It's a popular alternative to the SAT, ACT, or TOEFL for international students seeking to enroll in US colleges and universities. The test can also be used for job interviews and other situations that require proof of English skills.

2. Course Objectives

- To provide an affordable and convenient way to certify English skills.
- To serve as an alternative to traditional English proficiency exams.
- To assess English skills for academic, professional, and immigration purposes.
- To offer a fast and flexible testing experience with immediate results.

3. Learning Outcomes

- Demonstrate proficiency in reading, writing, listening and speaking.
- Understand and interpret spoken and written English.
- Apply English skills in practical task (summarizing, analyzing, responding).

- Adapt to changing difficulty levels of questions.
- Communicate effectively and fluently in formal and informal contexts.

4. Test format

• Introduction and Onboarding (5 minutes):

Review test rules, submit ID, and test the camera, speakers, and microphone.

• Adaptive Test (45 minutes):

A series of questions assessing reading, writing, listening and speaking. Question difficulty adjusts based on responses.

- Writing and Speaking Sample (10 minutes): Includes a prompt (image/text), a 1-3 minute speaking sample, and a 3-5 minute writing sample.
- Security and Results: Uses Data Forensics and AI technology for security. Results are available within 48 hours and can be sent to multiple institutions.
