### **An Overview**

The *PTE Academic Preparation Course Outline* is a foundation document to help with the design of preparation courses for PTE Academic. It provides a list of the suggested focus areas for lessons around which a preparation course can be built.

The course outline is based on the main communicative skills of **listening, speaking and writing** and their sub skills as listed in the *Official Guide to PTE Academic*. Each PTE Academic sub skill is presented in order, with correlation to the PTE Academic item types where each sub skill is tested. Because the course outline follows the organization of the *Official Guide*, sub skills are listed where they occur in the *Official Guide*; for example, note-taking from a lecture is included as a writing skill although it is an integrated skill with listening.

### **Course Objectives**

- To evaluate listening, reading, speaking, and writing skills.
- To test language skills for both academic and professional context.
- To offer an unbiased, computer-based assessment.
